



Kenneth Duke "PawPaw" Litman passed away peacefully on January 14, 2021 at his home on Lake Toledo Bend with his loving wife Terry by his side.

Ken was born on August 5, 1950 in Wheeling, West Virginia to Warren J. Litman and Zena B. Litman. His only sibling, Kathy Jan Litman was born 18 months later. The family lived in Cameron, West Virginia. His dad Warren was an insurance salesman in Cameron until the economy required the family to move to Houston, Texas in 1953. Ken graduated

from Spring Branch High School in 1968. He went to the University of Houston playing baseball and the drums in the band. Ken wrote a drum cadence that the University of Houston used at all their football games for several years. Ken graduated from the University of Houston with a Bachelors of Arts.

Ken worked for Farmers Insurance Company and retired in 2010 after 25 years. Ken and Terry were married on January 20, 2007. Ken and Terry both worked for Farmers Insurance Company. Upon their retirement he and Terry moved to their lake home on Lake Toledo Bend. Ken enjoyed fishing, boating, and pulling his grandchildren for hours behind their jet ski on tubes.

Ken began singing Barbershop with his dad at the age of 25. They were both part of the Houston Tidelanders Chorus. In 1976 Ken sang with the International Champion quartet, The Insiders, and toured England singing with them. In 1993 he sang with the quartet – Texans out of San Antonio, Texas where they won their District Contest. Ken was also a member of the quartet Inn's-N-Outt's and they also won their District Contest only after being a quartet for 4 weeks. In 1996 when Ken moved to Beaumont, Texas he was asked to direct the Chorus Harmony Exporters. It was at this point he, Wayne Wise, Lon Felps and Scott Brown formed the quartet Sound Trax.

Survivors include his wife Terry; sister Kathy Hall and husband Jim; son Chris Litman and wife Kim; daughter Kenna Litman-Russell and husband Chris; step-daughter Lauren Tozer and husband Justin; step-son Ryan Chapman and fiancée Lauren; nephew Josh Waller and wife Amber; grandchildren Jason Litman, Megan Litman, Kayleigh Litman and Madelyn Litman.
