

SCOTT ALLEN MICHAUD, born October 8, 1947, to Claude and Ernestine Belden Michaud, died suddenly on May 31, 2002 while on holiday in Paris, France. Scott attended Spring Branch High School in Houston, spending the summer prior to his senior year in France as a Foreign Exchange student. He earned his undergraduate degree and a Masters in Hospital Administration at Trinity University in San Antonio. Scott worked in Malibu, California for Medical Planning Associates. Upon moving to Austin he worked for Page, Sutherland & Page and for many years, he has been one of Austin's most successful realtors, associated with Pat Brown & Co. Scott was also an acclaimed expressionistic artist, having trained at Trinity, UCLA and the Instituto de San Miguel de Allende, Mexico. He also studied with the internationally acclaimed artist, Gustav Likan. He filled his canvases with brilliant colors and imaginative compositions, exhibiting his work in galleries in Mexico, Hawaii, Chicago, New York, Los Angeles, San Antonio and Austin. Survivors include his life partner, Don Roberts, mother, Ernestine Michaud Peters of Georgetown, Texas, sister, Claudia and husband Michael Cucco of Grapevine, Texas, and brother, Craig and wife Nancy Michaud of Springboro, Ohio. He also leaves many other relatives and countless friends whose hearts he touched and lives he changed.
