Donald Burnett Kerr, age 56, passed away peacefully September 10, 2015, in San Antonio, Texas. He was born in Houston, Texas on April 9, 1959 to parents Robert B. Kerr and Geraldine Jagers Kerr. From an early age, Don exhibited an extraordinarily tenacious spirit that lasted a lifetime. As a student he excelled in mathematics and the physical sciences, and earned a bachelors degree in mechanical engineering from Texas A & M University in 1981. After graduation, Don established himself as an engineer in the Houston area petroleum industry, first at Hydril Co., then at Hughes Elastomer Products, Interlock Technologies Corp., and finally at PCI Engineers. Don passionately enjoyed spending his free time working on cars, particularly his 1963 Ford Galaxy 500XL, which he lovingly restored and maintained. Life took a dramatic turn for Don in his 40th year when sudden and unexplainable health problems arose, causing him to move to the Canyon Lake area

to live with his parents. His final five years were spent battling devastating strokes that robbed him of his keen intellect and eventually took his life.

Don was predeceased by his mother, Geraldine Jagers Kerr; he is survived by his father, Robert B. Kerr of Spring Branch, Texas; brother Robert J. Kerr (Cynthia) and sister Kathleen Kerr Smith (David), both of San Antonio, Texas, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and grandnieces/nephews. Don loved the Lord and will be missed by all.
